- A. Scott Bogner Resignation
 - i. Board reviewed resignation letter and accepted
- B. Open Enrollment Dates
 - i. March 16th-29th
 - a. Dates were discussed in relation to the 2014 February open enrollment dates
 - b. Board acknowledged dates and asked Shane Malmquist to move quickly in getting the dates out to the public
- C. Appointment of Shane Malmquist
 - i. Board unanimously appointed Shane Malmquist as interim President of JPEC

VIII. Information Items

- A. Student Led Conferences
 - a. Shane Malmquist reported that student led conferences were implemented at the February 16th conference time

- b. Parents shared that they appreciated the push for innovation and that they were excited about the structure of holding students accountable for their learning
- c. Parents also shared that they desired to have more time for conferences and to have more face time with parents
- d. Shane Malmquist shared that feedback would be taking into consideration for the upcoming end of term conferences on April 8th

B. Enrollment Update

- a. February count was noted at 216 students which was a decrease of 20 students since the fall count day
- New families have been scheduling tours and informational meetings

C. Intersession

- a. Schedule for intercession is currently being built
 - i. Approximately 15 extension courses have been planned utilizing both faculty and community members
- b. Communication around the intercession will be sent out 3 weeks prior to the intercession
- c. JPEC will strive to allow students the opportunity to build schedules based on intervention, extension, and field work

D. Faculty Update

- a. Shane Malmquist shared that Kendra Adams had been terminated
 - i. A math opening had been posted by Employees Only
 - ii. The search for a new math teacher would begin
 - iii. Donna Lloyd would be filling in as the long term sub until the position is filled

E. PowerSchool Update

- a. JPEC is working with the JCISD closely on updating the structure and use of PowerSchool
 - Scheduling, grading, and parent data are three main goals for change
- b. JPEC working on modifying grading crosswalk within PowerSchool to better reflect the current evaluation system.

F. Athletics

- a. Shane Malmquist shared that Serafin Llerena has been working diligently on building athletic offerings for the spring
 - i. Cheer, soccer, tennis, and softball
- b. Parent volunteers have stepped up to support
- c. JPEC is considering different fundraising opportunities to support with athletics
