Online Learning	Earned through an approved JPEC course or a dual enrolled college course	0.5 Unit
Job Shadowing/ Community Service	 Choose One of the Following: 100 hours of verified community service (1 unit) A minimum of 40 hours of verified career exploration, internship, job shadowing, or clinical experience. (1 unit) A combination of the two that equals 70 or more hours. (1 unit) 	1 Unit
EMC Requirements	Every student must pass a minimum of 15 college credits (1 unit)	1 Unit
Academic Mentorship	Focus Group (*3 units per year of attendance) (15 units for 5 years)	Up to *15 units
